

AWAY FROM HOME BASE VOTING PROCEDURE

JULY 10th, 2009

As a point of clarification – we contacted Dave Ritchie’s office with the last vote and were advised that members off on GDIP, WSIB, or having a working assignment at another base would be allowed to vote at the station where they currently were. In other words if a members home base was in YWG but had a work assignment in YUL the member would be allowed to vote in YUL. The following procedure was to be followed. The member had to provide I.D. The station where he/she was voting would confirm with the member’s home base that he/she was entitled to vote. The home base would stroke the members name off the roster with black pen and the members name would be added to the bottom of the base he/she was voting at and the member would be shown as voting there. The ballot would be included with the total votes at the station where he/she was voting. Please call if you require further info.
